



ROAD CLOSURES

To ensure that we provide appropriate safety to the event participants and spectators, the following roads will be closed on Sunday 3 March 2024 at the times specified below:

Quay Street (between Lower Albert Street and The Strand)	4am to 12.00pm
Tamaki Drive (between Ngapipi Road and The Strand)	7am to 12.00pm
Tamaki Drive (between St Heliers Bay Road and Ngapipi Road)	7am to 1.45pm
Long Drive (between Tamaki Drive and Melanesia Road)	7am to 1.45pm
Auckland Road (between Tamaki Drive and Dingle Road)	7am to 1.45pm
Hanene Street, Kotiri Street, Pahaki Street, Speight Road and Aumoe Avenue (full length)	7am to 1.45pm
The Parade (between Tamaki Drive and Goldie Street)	7am to 1.45pm
Goldie Street (between Tamaki Drive and Kaimata Street)	7am to 1.45pm
Maheke Street (full length)	7am to 1.45pm
Benbow Street (between St Heliers Bay Road and Goldie Street)	7am to 1.45pm
Polygon Road (between St Heliers Bay Road and Goldie Street)	7am to 1.45pm
Long Drive (between Melanesia Road and Towai Street)	10.30am to 1.45pm
Allum Street (between Melanesia Road and Towai Street)	10.30am to 1.45pm
Melanesia Road (between Sage Road and Auckland Road)	10.30am to 1.45pm
Auckland Road (between Long Drive and Dingle Road)	10.30am to 1.45pm
Challenger Street (full length)	10.30am to 1.45pm
Dingle Road (between Auckland Road and The Parade)	10.30am to 1.45pm

Our traffic management provider in consultation with police may allow residents/business movements inside of the road closures above where deemed safe to do so. No further movements will take place until the roads are re-opened.

Emergency vehicles only will be able to gain access in collaboration with NZ Police.

NOTE: Roads will be opened progressively as the roads clear of foot traffic and waste is removed. Safety is paramount.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

To support the road closures the below strict no parking restrictions will be in place:

From 7.00am Saturday 2 March 2024 to 3.00pm Sunday 3 March 2024

- 10 x parks on Goldie Street - adjacent to Vellenoweth Green. From 9.00pm Saturday 2 March 2024 until 3.00pm Sunday 3 March 2024
- All other parks on Goldie Street - adjacent to Vellenoweth Green.

From 4.00am until 1.45pm on Sunday 3 March 2024 on the below streets

- **Tangihua Street from Beach Road to Quay Street**
- **Quay Street from Queen Street to The Strand**
- **Tamaki Drive from The Strand to Sage Road**
- **Polygon Road from St Heliers Bay Road to Goldie Street**
- **Baddeley Avenue from Melanesia Road to Southern Cross Road Ronaki Road, and applies for 100m south of Marau Crescent only The Parade from Tamaki Drive to Goldie Street**
- **Tamaki Drive from Sage Road to St Heliers Bay Road**
- **Goldie Street from Tamaki Drive to The Parade.**

From 4.00am until 2.30pm on Sunday 3 March 2024 on the below streets

- **Hanene Street (full length)**
- **Speight Road from Hanene Street to Long Drive**
- **Taranaki Road from Melanesia Road to Kohimarama Road, Northern kerb only Long Drive from Tamaki Drive to Towai Street**
- **Melanesia Road from Sage Road to Baddeley Avenue.**

Parking wardens will be onsite to clear any vehicles that have parked inappropriately. Towed vehicles can be reclaimed by calling the contact phone number on parking restriction signage that will be displayed within the road closure areas.

Buses carrying participants will depart pre-event from The Parade and Melanesia Road (Madills Farm) and post event from Long Drive and Melanesia Road (Madills Farm).

Access for residents and businesses in Tangihua Street, Tinley Street and Plumer Street will be maintained from Beach Road only.

Access for trucks into the Ports and Tooley Street will be maintained and managed from the Strand until the full closure is in place. Please check the Round the Bays website for more details www.roundthebays.co.nz
